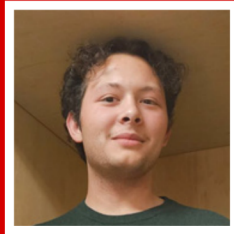

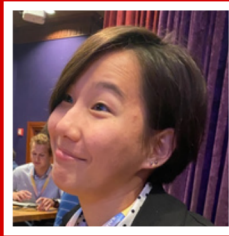
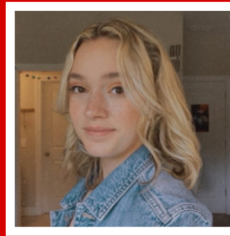
## Design Teams
