

The Silence of the Lambs (1991)

One of my favorite movies of all time, The Silence of the Lambs showcases FBI training student Clarice Starling and her interviews with infamous psychiatrist and psychopath Dr. Hannibal Lecter, who is currently serving life in maximum-security prison for various murders and acts of cannibalism. The movie follows Starling's work as she attempts to extract valuable information Dr. Lecter may have about an ongoing case.

The Blair Witch Project (1999)

This one's definitely a cult classic. Its plot revolves around three student filmmakers who disappear in the remote woods near Burkittsville, MD while attempting to film a documentary about the mythical Blair Witch. What's fascinating about the movie's style is that it's presented as a series of found footage clips pieced together, so you really experience the horror firsthand.

Hereditary (2018)

As the title suggests, Hereditary is all about family, specifically the Graham family. It follows the death of their grandmother Ellen and, as the family mourns, they begin to unravel a cryptic, horrifying web of secrets about their lineage. Again, another one of my absolute favorites and an incredible performance from Toni Colette (this is that movie with the "I am your mother!" scene).

Get Out (2017)

Get Out is one of those movies that really keeps you guessing what'll happen next. It stars Daniel Kaluuya as Chris, who drives upstate with his girlfriend to visit her family for the weekend. The family seems to at first simply be a little strange and over-accommodating to Chris, however, a series of disturbing discoveries gradually lead to a horrifying truth about them.

An extra few that I ran out of space to include are Rosemary's Baby, Skinamarink, Bones and All, and Jennifer's Body– as well as the TV shows Yellowjackets and Hannibal!
