How do I register for classes for Spring 2023?

Course Request is the two-week period each semester during which you are permitted to request courses for Spring 2023. Course request opened up on October 18th, 2022 and it will close on November 1st, 2022.

What do I need to Course Request?

You register for classes online, via Hokie Spa. You will need your major (or intended major) check sheet, and CRN for each class you wish to take, as this is the information you plug in to enroll in a course.

How does Course Request work?

Course Request is not your actual schedule for next semester, but it is used to determine which courses a student should be scheduled to take in the upcoming school year. You are requesting what classes you want to take.

They are granted in this order: senior honors, senior, junior honors, junior, and so on. **It DOES NOT matter if you are the FIRST person to use Course Request - or the last. Preference is based on class rank, not on timing.**

When will I find out what classes I got?

It will take about three weeks to get your results posted on HokieSpa.

Step by step for the first time to course request!

1. Go to Hokie Spa
2. **HOW TO FIND CRN**
 - a. Course Request Numbers (CRNS) can be found on the Timetable of Classes beside each class listing.
 - b. OR Click Registration (Add/Drop) and Schedule > Browse Classes > Select term > Enter your Subject or Prefix and Course Number.
3. Click on Course Request
4. Add Course Request Numbers and Click ADD CRNs.
5. **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE AT LEAST 12 CREDITS TO BE REGISTERED FOR NEXT SEMESTER!!!**
